

'Read to Learn' workshop for senior students held at Medo Library

MEDO, Aug 24: 'Read to Learn' workshop, a novel programme to connect library habits for senior students, was organised by Medo Youth Library, on August 22 and 23 at the Brahmakumari Centre Hall here. The Forum of Activists of Lohit Youth Libraries conducted the workshop to popularise reading habits among the students of rural areas. Students of the Medo Govt Secondary School and a few other schools in Wakro Circle participated.

Inaugurating the workshop, Dr Sopai Tawsik, chief patron, Medo Youth Library lauded the Forum for taking a novel initiative to target the senior students and help them improve their academic levels through library activities.
