Book exhibitions, reading campaign thrill Tezu students

TEZU, Aug 24: The District Education Dept, Lohit along with Bamboosa Library and CALSOM, Tezu organised a reading campaign and book exhibitions in Tezu covering the local schools, from Aug 8 to 22.

The reading campaign was led by senior reader-activists of Bamboosa Library with teacher-volunteers, who went round the local schools, conducting reading demonstrations, training in loud reading, poetry recitation and tips on the correct handling of books and magazines. They also introduced different youth magazines to the schools and presented them complimentary copies.

This was followed by two book exhibitions at the Middle School No.3 and the CALSOM Library, thus enabling students across Tezu town to visit the centre nearest to them. The book exhibition at Middle School No.3 organised by ViTAES, was inaugurated on behalf of DDSE, by S S Malan, BEO (Acad), while the exhibition at CALSOM Library was inaugurated by Jabralum Chaitom, vice chairman, CALSOM.

The exhibition mainly featured books from Eklavya Bhopal, a leading educational publisher, with a range of stimulating books for teachers and very enchanting reader friendly books for young readers. Books of prominent educationists like John Holt, and popular science-educator Arvind Gupta drew several grownups, officials including DDSE Mana Linggi to the exhibition.

A painting contest for students was also organised by CALSOM Library during the exhibition. Students from many Govt & private schools visited the exhibitions.
